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Preliminary Agreement

Good Samaritan Waiver- Flight Instructors will gladly assist other members with the understanding that hard landings can happen for many reasons. Instructors are not responsible when mishaps occur.

1. All pilots are expected to pre-flight their aircraft for safety and reliability. Student pilots should consult a Flight Instructor with questions and a visual check when needed. All aircraft must be labeled with the required identification and ID numbers. It is requested that all pilots display their identification badges when flying.
2. Volunteering is essential to preserving our club and providing good stewardship of the land. All members are encouraged to contribute at some level when possible.
3. Members are expected to utilize mutual respect toward all other members and guests. Serious threats, either verbal or physical, will not be tolerated and will be grounds for dismissal.
4. We encourage all members to help when another pilot has a need, or quickly consult with a Flight Instructor when safety is a concern. Guidance should be made professionally by a subtle reminder when an established guideline or safety issue is a concern. Repeat offenses should be reported to the Safety Officer or another club officer if needed.
5. We are the caretakers of this public Greenway area. It is the responsibility of all members to keep the area clean and protected. Everyone should feel comfortable giving a friendly reminder to others who may forget.
6. New members and club leadership will both have 60 days to determine if the club is a good fit.
7. Helicopters, drones, and other FPV (First Person Viewing aircraft) can fly at the field, but they are different, and have the potential to be a safety concern. There is a designated area for FPV on the West end of the field, however, both may fly on the main field, if there are no safety concerns, and other members present give the OK. **FPV flyers must always have a spotter.**
8. All members must agree to read and acknowledge the bylaws and safety standards established by the club. _____Initial. They can be found online at tricountryrcdunnellonflorida.com or requested.
9. To maximize existing table use, please do not use the prep tables as a hanger during busy times. We ask that you move your aircraft off the tables to allow arriving members to access them for their setup.
10. This agreement form shall be reviewed and signed as part of the application for admission to the Tri County R/C Club.
